


TRIVAC 700 Pressure Pool Cleaner owners manual



SAFETY FACTS

CARTON CONTENTS

DO NOT use to remove large debris in new pools.

REMOVE the cleaner before chemically shocking your pool

DO NOT swim with cleaner

Store the cleaner in a shaded safe area


Hoses must be stored straight. DO NOT coiled the hose

REMOVE cleaner when performing backwash


Filtration pump Pool chemicals






PREPARING THE POOL

Manually remove very large and excessive debris from pool (ie. post storm, spring cleaning / pool opening situations).



Perform a backwash, clean your filter, skimmer baskets and pump basket.



POOL CHEMICALS




pH: 7.2 - 7.6

Chlorine: 0.5 - 1.5 P.P.M

Total Alkalinity: 80 - 150 P.P.M

DEDICATED RETURN LINE




CONNECTING THE TRIVAC

INSTALLING WALL FITTING












When installing or reinstalling the universal wall fitting use Teflon tape on its plastic threads.



Remove plug or existing universal wall fitting from previously installed pool cleaner (if any).



Screw the universal wall fitting into the dedicated line. (see p.4)




Connect pressure hose with the wall quick connect

SIZING PRESSURE HOSE


DEBRIS BAG

SIZING THE HOSE

Pull hose to farthest point of the pool.




Measure from end of the hose to 2-3 ft over the edge of the pool.




Disconnect the last portion of hose and cut the measured amount from the last section of the 8' hose.




DO NOT cut the sweep hose



Reconnect the last hose portion.




ATTACHING DEBRIS BAG




REMOVING DEBRIS BAG

Pull the top of the debris bag frame back and then up.



CLEANING DEBRIS BAG





Full debris bag can reduce cleaner performance.




if you allow the bag to dry it will be easier to remove the debris

SETTING PRESSURE


OPERATING THE TRIVAC




Too much pressure will cause poor cleaning and premature wear of cleaner parts



Use a flat blade screwdriver to adjust the wall quick connect knob to reach 25 PSI (+/- 5)









CHANGING BOTTOM TO SKIM

To skim the pool surface rotate the switch to the arrow up for the SKIM mode.



CHANGING SKIM TO BOTTOM

To clean the bottom and sides of the pool rotate the switch to the arrow down for the BOTTOM mode




ADJUSTING THE SWEEP HOSE

MAINTENANCE

ADJUSTING SWEEP HOSE POWER


SWEEP HOSE MOVE SLOWLY OR NOT AT ALL: turn the adjustment knob counter-clockwise to increase sweep hose power.




SWEEP HOSE FREQUENTLY SPRAYS OUT OF THE POOL: turn the adjusment knob clockwise to reduce sweep hose power.



Note: Do not turn the sweep hose completely off. This can cause the hose to tangle or knot.







REMOVE CLEANER FROM POOL








CLEANING THE IN-LINE FILTER





if the screen frequently becomes plugged, the filtration system is not performing properly or there is another plumbing problem.





Make sure the o-ring is in place and properly seated.

REPLACING PARTS

SWEEP HOSE

If a hole forms in the sweep hose, it should be replaced. Unscrew the mender nut from the hose and pull the sweep hose off the cleaner connector. Attach a new sweep hose to the cleaner connector.

SWEEP HOSE ROLLERS


The Sweep hose rollers are wear parts. When the rollers wear-down to the outer groove (wear line) replace the wear roller.



DEBRIS BAG

The debris bag should be replaced if it is torn.



SWIVELS


If a swivel ceases to turn easily or leaks while the cleaner is running, it should be replaced.

PART NUMBER: AX5000SA
*Jetted swivel PART NUMBER: AX5000JSA




TIRES

The tires are wear parts. When the tires wear-down to the wear marks replace the tire.



SIDE ROLLERS

The side rollers are wear parts. When the side rollers wear-down, replace the side rollers.

PROBLEM	CAUSE	SOLUTION
Slow or no forward move- ment	Low or no water pressure	Check filtration and booster pumps, valves, cleaner connections. Check Cleaner pressure.
Cleaner does not reach farthest point in pool	Hose too short	Check hose length
Hose frequently tangles	Float not properly placed	Check float is centered on the two-foot hose connected to the pipe closest to the cleaner
	Hose too long	Check hose length
	Sweep hose not moving	Check sweep hose for holes or clogs, increase sweep hose power.
Sweep hose sprays out of pool	Sweep hose power too strong	Reduce sweep hose power
Little or no sweep hose movement	Sweep hose power too weak	Increase hose power
	Hole in sweep hose	Replace sweep hose
	Debris clogging sweep hose	Disconnect sweep hose and flush out
Trivac running on side or upside down	Heavy debris	Empty Bag
	Pressure too high	Check operating pressure
Cleaner cannot climb to the surface in TOP mode	Pressure too high or too low	Check operating pressure
	Too much heavy debris in bag	Empty bag
Cleaner runs in small circles	Hose on hose cleaner end assembly bent	Layout in sun until straight

To original purchasers of this equipment, Hayward Pool Products, Inc, warrants these cleaners to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of TWO (2) year from the date of purchase, when used in single family residential applications.

Parts that fail from a defect or become defective during the warranty period shall be repaired or replaced, at our option, within 90 days of the receipt of defective product, barring unforeseen delays, without charge.
